



Georgian Wines

Wine is part of Georgian heritage, associated with celebrations, holidays and religion. Archeologists have carbon-dated accumulations of grape pips (as evidence of wine-making) in Georgia, dating from 7000-5000 BC. Both red and white wine are produced commercially in several regions of Georgia. These wines are known throughout the world, and respected by American wine-makers. Using over 500 variety of grapes, Georgians produce wines of amazing purity.

***Kindzmarauli* (750ML) \$35.00**

A high quality naturally semi-sweet wine of dark-red color. It is made from the Saperavi grape variety cultivated on the slopes of the Caucasian mountains in the Kvareli district of Kakheti. It has a strong characteristic bouquet and aroma, a gentle harmonious and velvety taste. The wonderful taste and curative properties have won Kindzmarauli general recognition.

***Saperavi* (750ML) \$35.00**

Made from the Saperavi grape variety from 30-50 year old vineyards. This unique wine is fermented in Kakheti by ancient Georgian method, which naturally guarantees constant temperature during the whole winemaking process. The result is a deep wine with a characteristic bouquet, a harmonious taste and pleasant astringency. Wine has purely varietal aroma of cherry and blackberry without oak influence. It has been produced since 1886.

***Pirosmani* (750ml) \$35.00**

A medium dry wine made from the Saperavi varietal. It has intense ruby color with a violet hue. On the nose there are notes of ripe cherries with hints of prunes. To taste it is full, soft yet spicy and leads to an incredibly long and well balanced finish.

***Ojaleshi* (750ml) \$35.00**

This semi-dry wine is made from the Ojaleshi grape variety cultivated in the mountainous region samegrelo in western Georgia. A powerful, deep ruby color expresses an essence of ripe cherries and raspberries. Extremely sophisticated and elegant palate, with a delightful balance of fruitiness and tannic structure.
